
Display Positive Behavior...

Extended Day Program

It is offered to all students from Kindergarten to Eighth grade however, space availability for grade levels are limited. Placement is filled on a first come first serve basis for only Royal Palm Charter School students and will be available Monday through Friday including some of the no school days (teacher work days only).

The cost of the program will be **\$60.00** a week or **\$15.00** a day or **\$20** for before care only. The cost for Teacher Work Days will be an additional **\$20.00**

The hours of Royal Palm's before care program is 6:00 am – 7:30 am and the after school program will open at 3:00 pm and will close at 6:00 pm. Please keep in mind **all children must be picked up by 6:00 pm.**

Screening/Testing For Kindergarten?


Our Kindergarten students will begin school on:
