

# Royal Palm Charter School Uniform Policy

Appropriate school attire is required for each child. The school uniform is to be worn Monday through Friday. Please remember, all shirts are to be tucked into the bottom garment Monday through Thursday.

Kindergarten through Fifth grade students will wear a hunter green polo uniform shirt with khaki bottoms and Sixth through Eighth grade students will wear a royal blue polo uniform shirt with khaki bottoms.

Uniform khaki slacks, shorts, skirts, skorts, and jumpers for all grade levels are not required to be purchased from a specific supplier, but they must be free of designs or logos, stains, rips, and tears.

For Middle School students with PE every day, they may dress out in a plain colored t-shirt and black basketball shorts.

Uniforms will need to be replaced when torn or stained.

Tennis shoes are most appropriate for daily wear. If tennis shoes are not worn, a pair should be brought from home for use during P.E. and recess. Sandals, Crocs, or open-toed shoes are **NOT** permitted; students must wear closed-toe shoes.

Pants need to be secured at the waist - not down on the hips. Shorts and skirts should be fingertip in length on the thigh.

Hair color should be natural shades. Kool-Aid dyes or other unnatural hair colors are not acceptable.

On Fridays, students may wear a leadership shirt and **BLUE** jeans. Pants, skirts, skorts, or shorts are acceptable, but they must be blue, free of rips/holes, or designs.

Dress-down day attire follows uniform rules. No undergarments may be visible.

## Key Points:

- Shirts must be tucked in at all times
- Torn or stained uniforms must be replaced
- Skirts/Shorts must be at least to mid-thigh/finger-tip in length
- Pants or shorts that are too big or too tight for the student, as determined by the Administration, are not acceptable and will be in violation of the uniform code
- Loosely worn and lowly worn pants are not acceptable - pants must be fastened at waist level
- Any clothing or accessories that are suggestive, revealing, indecent, discriminatory or offensive are not allowed
- All headgear (hats, scarves, hoodies, etc) are prohibited within the school building
- Jackets are not to be tied around the waist
- 6-8 grade students may change into plain shirts and black gym shorts, but students must change back to regular attire before the next class, and shorts cannot be seen underneath khaki shorts

## Consequences for Dress Code Violations:

**1st Offense** - Warning and parent notification

**2nd Offense** - Lunch detention and parent notification

**3rd Offense** - After-school detention and call home for a change of clothes

**4th Offense**+- Sent home with an unexcused absence
